Universitetsplatsen



Lund University was founded in 1666 and is one of Sweden's most attractive study destination.

Universitetsplatsen was

conceived by Helgo Zettervall as a harminious whole, with Universitetshuset and the Academic Society (AF) opposite one another. As a counterbalance to Kungshuset on the south side of the square, Zettervall erected Palaestra et Odeum on the north side. In the centre stands a two-storey fountain surrounded by flowerbeds. The four iron frogs spouting water around are populary known as the "faculty frogs"

Universitetshuset, the main university building was erected in 1878-1882. Today the building houses the offices of the university management and parts of the central administration, and provides facilities for official entertainment and ceremonies. From 30th of June until the 8th of August the building is open to public on weekdays between 2 pm-4 pm.
